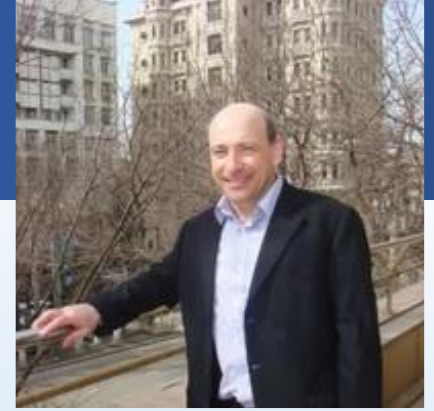


Speaker on High Quality Dev Modernization and Policies nexus Induced by COVID-19



Dr. Minsoo Lee

- He currently works at Regional Cooperation and Operations Coordination Division in Central and West Asia Department at Asian Development Bank as a Senior Economist.
- In April 2020, he transferred from the People's Republic of China Resident Mission, where he headed the Knowledge Hub. In that posting, he led ADB's assistance to the PRC government in the preparation of the 14th Five-Year Plan, and worked on policy projects with the National Development and Reform Commission, the Development Research Center of the State Council, the International Poverty Reduction Center in China, China Development Research Foundation, CAREC Institute and research institutes in private sector.
- He joined the ADB's Economic Research and Regional Cooperation Department in 2011. He led the team writing ADB's flagship publication, the Asian Development Outlook, and its theme chapters Asia's Energy Challenge (2013), Meeting the Low-Carbon Growth Challenge (2016 update), and Sustaining Development through Public–Private Partnership (2017). Before joining ADB, he was an Associate Dean and Full Professor of the Peking University HSBC Business School in China. He holds Master's degrees in economics and applied mathematics from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and a PhD in economics from Washington State University.

- For two years before joining the CAREC Institute, Hans was Lead Economist for Central Asia with the EBRD, based in Almaty, Kazakhstan. Hans has 30 years of experience as an Economist focusing on transition economies. He was Chief Economist at Golomt Bank in Mongolia and of ATFBank in Kazakhstan. He was also teaching at the Turan and Narxoz universities in Almaty. Earlier, he was a Vienna-based Senior Economist focused on Russia and Ukraine for Bank Austria, a member of UniCredit group, and was also in charge of CEE country rating.
- Hans was Senior Economist covering the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Slovenia, and Ukraine at the Institute of International Finance in Washington, DC, during 1999-2001, Head of Country Risk/Research at GiroCredit Research, Investmentbank Austria during 1993-99, and Central European Economist at Nomura Research Institute during 1989-93. Hans holds a Ph.D. in Sociology and a MA in Economics from the University of Vienna. He completed a postgraduate scholarship in the Economics Department of the Institute for Advanced Studies in Vienna.
