Bio of Dr. Minsoo Lee

Dr. Minsoo Lee currently works at Regional Cooperation and Operations Coordination Division in Central and West Asia Department at Asian Development Bank as a Senior Economist. In April 2020, he transferred from the People's Republic of China Resident Mission, where he headed the Knowledge Hub. In that posting, he led ADB's assistance to the PRC government in the preparation of the 14th Five-Year Plan, and worked on policy projects with the National Development and Reform Commission, the Development Research Center of the State



Council, the International Poverty Reduction Center in China, China Development Research Foundation, CAREC Institute and research institutes in private sector. He joined the ADB's Economic Research and Regional Cooperation Department in 2011. He led the team writing ADB's flagship publication, the *Asian Development Outlook*, and its theme chapters Asia's Energy Challenge (2013), Meeting the Low-Carbon Growth Challenge (2016 update), and Sustaining Development through Public—Private Partnership (2017). Before joining ADB, he was an Associate Dean and Full Professor of the Peking University HSBC Business School in China. He holds Master's degrees in economics and applied mathematics from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and a PhD in economics from Washington State University.
