# MoU on CPEC – $5^{TH}$ July 2013



- Salient features of the MoU
  - CPEC will promote bilateral connectivity and regional economic integration, explore potential bilateral investment, economic and trade, logistic and people-to-people connectivity
  - The cooperation plan includes but not limited to:
    - a. Formulating LTP-for CPEC (2015-30), defining overall direction, ideas and goals of cooperation.
    - b. Communication networks including roads, railways, fiber optic cables, and oil & gas pipelines linking Western China with Gwadar, Pakistan.
    - c. Explore sectoral cooperation and exchanges in agriculture, industrial park construction, manufacturing, and energy.
    - d. Cooperation in education, culture, tourism and media through cultural and local government to government exchanges.

**e.** Conduct dialogues and research on economic cooperation and fields of mutual interest.

# CPEC-Long-Term Plan (2015-30)



Early Harvest and Short Term Projects

**1st Target (2020)** : **Period of market cultivation**, major bottlenecks to Pakistan's economic and social development shall be addressed to boost the economic growth.

Medium Term Projects

• 2nd Target (2025) : Period of expansion and development. Processing and manufacturing industries will be developed, significant improvement in the people's livelihood, balanced regional economic development, and all the goals of Vision 2025 achieved.

Long Term Projects

• **3rd Target (2030)** : **Period of Maturity**. The endogenous mechanism for sustainable economic growth will be in place, the CPEC ready to play leadership role in the region.

### **CPEC- PHASE II- VISION STATEMENT**


Accelerate economic, industrial, technological and agricultural development of Pakistan through Chinese investment and transfer of technology

## Facilitation for Chinese Investors

- CPEC Authority to set up "Investment Facilitation Centre" to offer "One Window Operation" to all Chinese investors
- SEZs Management companies should be fully empowered having capacity and capability to facilitate investors
- Cabinet Committee on CPEC (CCoCPEC) and Pak China Relationship Steering Committee would be leveraged to address unresolved issues

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






#### Regional Connectivity-Rail link
