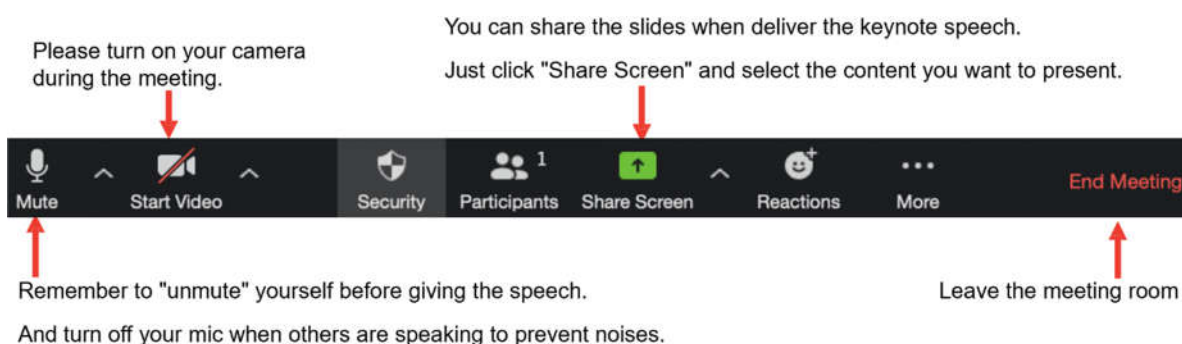

Kashi University

Kashi University (KSU) is located in China's famous historical and cultural city, China's excellent tourist city ---Kashi, which has been known as a city "adjoining five ports throughout eight countries, all the way to Europe and Asia". Kashi University is the westernmost part of the motherland, so the mission of cultivating basic education teachers and application-oriented talents needed for economic and social development.

Kashi University, Founded in 1962, was formerly known as Kashi Teachers College. In the 16 years from its establishment to the end of the year 1978, it was the only higher normal college of five higher education institutions in Xinjiang Urghur Autonomous Region (Xinjiang University, Xinjiang Engineering College, Bayi Agricultural College, Xinjiang Medical College, Xinjiang Kashi Teachers College), which has been playing an irreplaceable and important role in basic education, social stability and economic development in Xinjiang, especially in southern Xinjiang. At the year of 1978, it was upgraded to an undergraduate institution and changed its name to Kashi Teachers College. In 2003, it obtained the qualification of a master's degree authorization unit and began to undertake the task of training postgraduates. In 2007, it achieved excellent results in the evaluation of the undergraduate teaching level of the Ministry of Education. In 2012, it was listed as a university for basic capacity constructive projects in central and western universities. In April 2015, it was renamed Kashi University. In June 2016, it was identified as one of the 100 pilot universities for transformation and development in the country. In 1994 and 2009, it was awarded the honorary title of "National Model Collective of National Unity and Progress" by the State Council twice. In 2014, the Department of Chinese Language was awarded the honorary title of "National Model Collective of National Unity and Progress" by the State Council.

The university currently has 16 teaching units and 55 undergraduate majors (including 4 professional directions), covering nine disciplines: science, engineering, literature, education, art, law, economics, management, and history. There are 5 first-level discipline master's degree authorization points and 7 master's professional degree authorization points. There are 1 national-level pilot project for the comprehensive reform of undergraduate majors, 1 state-level off-campus practical education base for college students, 3 key disciplines at the autonomous region level, 1 major in the shortage of talents in key industries in the autonomous region, 1 demonstration major in innovation and entrepreneurship in the autonomous region, 1 strategic emerging major in the autonomous region, 2 key research bases for humanities and social sciences in ordinary colleges and universities in the autonomous region, 2 key laboratories at the autonomous region level, 3 experimental

teaching demonstration centers, 1 autonomous region-level engineering technology research center, and 1 autonomous region science and technology innovation team.

The university currently has 1,255 faculty members, including 804 full-time teachers, and 631 teachers with master's degrees or above, accounting for 78.48%, including 156 doctors, 313 teachers with the title of associate professors or above, accounting for 38.93%.

We now have 23,054 students on two campuses, Gaotai and Xinquan, covering an area of 1,660,700 square meters, with advanced teaching facilities and a comfortable teaching environment. The library covers a total area of 53,000 square meters, with a collection of 1.38 million books and 700,000 kinds of e-books. 13 databases such as CNKI, Wanfang, VIP, and Chaoxing are ordered. The campus network and 5G communication network cover the whole campuses, which can meet the needs of talents training in the information age. The total value of teaching equipment reaches 260 million yuan, and we have complete and high-standard teaching experimental equipment and cultural, sports, health and other facilities to meet the needs of teaching, which can also comprehensively guarantee and serve the teaching and scientific research as well as personnel training.

Kashi University has adhered to the spirit of "Populus-like Tenacity and Red Candle Dedication", condensed the school motto of "Harmony and Tolerance, Inspiration and Strength", and formed the ideology of "stability as the premise, teaching as the center, discipline construction as the direction, improving the quality of teaching as the lifeline, focusing on the construction of the teaching staff, and cultivating qualified talents as the goal". We have trained more than 100,000 basic education teachers and various specialized talents with good virtues and moral cultivation and solid professional skills.

To face the heavy responsibility in the new era, all teachers and students of Kashi University have the courage to innovate, dare to take responsibilities, adhere to the socialist direction in managing, focus on the overall goal of social stability and long-term peace and stability in Xinjiang, strive to build it into a school with distinctive regional characteristics, outstanding advantages in teachers education, perfect application-oriented talent training system, and influential multidisciplinary and applied universities in the surrounding areas, and strive to make greater contributions to the basic education and economic and social development of Xinjiang, especially in southern Xinjiang.

Research Center of China- Pakistan Economic Corridor (K SU)

Research Center of China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CCPEC), located at Kashi University, the westernmost university in China, is one of the national and regional research centers of National Ethnic Affairs Commission of PRC (NEAC) on the Belt and Road.

CCPEC was initiated as Kashi Institute for China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) in 2018, recognized as a national and regional research center of NEAC on the Belt and Road in August, 2020, and officially established in December, 2020.

CCPEC is dedicated to integrating research resources in the field of Belt and Road and CPEC, promoting national and regional researches on the Belt and Road, serving the overall situation of national strategy and diplomatic affairs, opening up to the outside world for economic and social development, and striving to build an innovative and open-ended high-level research platform, a new type of university think tank and a talent training base, integrating scientific research, consulting services, academic exchanges and talent training.

CCPEC takes advantage of the location and humanities of Kashi University at the starting point of CPEC in China, actively carries out academic exchanges and cooperation, integrates relevant intellectual resources at home and abroad, establishes academic exchanges and cooperation with more than 30 universities and national think tanks including the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, the Development Research Center of the State Council, Peking University, Tsinghua University, Nankai University, Pakistan Center for Strategic Studies, the National Defense University of Pakistan, and the Pakistan University of Science and Technology. CCPEC has organized the "Muztagata Forum ---International Symposium on CPEC to Commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between China and Pakistan" and "Pamir Forum for Philanthropy", provided decision-making proposals to NEAC, Ministry of Education and Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region, and gradually exerted academic influence in research on the high-quality development of CPEC.

In the future, CCPEC will also carry out multi-level and multi-dimensional academic research, support the publication and transformation of high-level research fruits, and play an increasingly important role in scientific research, cultural leadership and social services of Kashi University in the economic and social development of CPEC.

CAREC Institute

The Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation (CAREC) Institute is an intergovernmental organization dedicated to promoting the economic cooperation in the Central Asia and along the Silk Road through knowledge generation and sharing. The Institute is headquartered in Urumqi, Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region, the People's Republic of China (PRC). The CAREC Institute is jointly shared, owned, and governed by eleven member countries: Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, the PRC, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, Pakistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Uzbekistan. It is a knowledge support arm of the CAREC Program which is a proactive facilitator of practical, results-based regional projects, and policy initiatives critical to sustainable economic growth and shared prosperity in the region, guided by the overarching vision of "Good Neighbors, Good Partners, and Good Prospects." The Institute acts as a knowledge connector among the five CAREC clusters to ensure coherence in design and implementation of policies, programs, and projects to promote regional economic cooperation and integration. To fulfill its objectives, the CAREC Institute:

- Provides high-impact knowledge solutions and analytical underpinnings to facilitate an inclusive regional cooperation for catalyzing balanced development solutions synergizing national development challenges and priorities with regional aspirations.
- Facilitates sharing of good practices of the region and the world to enable the member countries to respond effectively to regional challenges and capitalize on opportunities.
- Enhances the capabilities of government officials to engage in regional cooperation processes, design and implement regional cooperation projects, and conduct sophisticated policy analysis for informed policy decisions.
- Conducts strategic research by mobilizing relevant intellectual resources to enhance regional cooperation and accelerate growth.
- Improves the effectiveness of decision making among the member countries through facilitation of policy dialogue and dissemination of findings at high-level platforms.
- Promotes regional alliances and facilitates development of think tanks in the region to serve as a resource base for strategic research and knowledge sharing.

Overview of Shenzhen's aid to Xinjiang

In accordance with the arrangements of the Central Committee of CPC and the State Council, since the launch of the new round of counterpart assistance to Xinjiang, Shenzhen, has provided counterpart support to Kashi City and Tashkurgan County in Xinjiang. Since 2010, it has dispatched 1,432 cadres and talents to aid Xinjiang, directly invested 11.534 billion RMB, and organized the implementation and promotion of 822 various aid projects in Xinjiang.

We promote the construction of such high-quality projects as the widest Shenka Avenue, the Shenzhen Industrial Park, the Shenzhen-Kazakh Science and Technology Innovation Service Center, the Shenzhen-Kazakh Modern Agricultural Industry Demonstration Park, and the first comprehensive free trade zone in southern Xinjiang; We assist in the construction and creation of 2 national 5A-level tourist scenic spots and 2 4A-level tourist scenic spots, and fully promote the construction of the Tashkurgan Global Tourism Demonstration Zone; We support the construction of 66,500 sets of housing in safe and prosperous homes, help 18,253 households be registered as poor family and 74,711 people get rid of poverty, with 4,074 households registered as poor family and 16,505 people out of poverty in Tashkurgan; We vigorously support the construction of the Moor Temple Relic Park, carry out the care action in wisdom reading of Chinese studies, and continue to promote the three-dimensional deepening of cultural development; We promote the establishment of a linkage mechanism and platform for the industry and talent work in Shenzhen, and vigorously promote Tencent, PingAn, BYD and other enterprises to deepen their cultivation in Kashi; We support the opening of the Shenzhen-Kazakh direct flight, the Southern Xinjiang Highway Express and the Shenzhen-Sui-Ka-South Asia Freight Train; We build a rural revitalization demonstration town in Patrick Township of Kashi City, and Bandier Township of Tashkurgan, and support the construction of a 10,000-mu seawater rice base; We have built, renovated and expanded 4 hospitals, supported in the construction of 162 kindergartens, 13 primary and secondary schools, provided more than 63,000 high-quality basic education degrees, and invested 1 billion RMB to help build the Xinquan Campus of Kashi University which has now become an important base for the training of comprehensive talents in southern Xinjiang.

Shenzhen will continue to take the spirit and responsibility of taking the lead in setting an example, do its best to serve the needs of Kashi, and strive to make new Shenzhen contributions to building a beautiful Xinjiang that is united, harmonious, prosperous, civilized, progressive, ecology-friendly for people living and working in peace and contentment.

Introduction to K E D Z

Kashi Economic Development Zone is a national-level economic development zone and a national-level free trade zone approved by the CPC Central Committee and the State Council. It is an important part of the "one port, two districts, five centers, and port economic belt" in the core area of the Silk Road Economic Belt. It is responsible for the mission of building it into an important window for China's opening to the west, and the national strategic mission of promoting the formation of a new pattern of opening up that places equal emphasis on "opening on land" and "opening at sea". The planned area of the Kashi Economic Development Zone is 50 square kilometers, including 40 square kilometers in the main Kashi Park and 10 square kilometers in the Irkeshtam Port Park in Kizilsu Kirghiz Autonomous Prefecture. The construction of the main Kashi park was started in July 2012, and it took 10 years to initially build a modern industrial new city on a Gobi Desert.

Kashi Economic Development Zone has implemented the strategy of "Eastern and Northern" zones advancing in parallel, focusing on ten major actions such as precise investment promotion, industrial quality improvement, employment promotion, business environment optimization, which has made significant achievements. The infrastructure has been improved gradually, with 11.58 billion yuan invested in the "13th Five Year Plan", and a road network system with smooth traffic in and out of the region and a rail, road and air multi-modal transport system have been initially built. In 2021, the investment in fixed assets of the whole society will be 4.37 billion RMB, with a year-on-year growth of 53.7%. The 34-kilometer road in the Chengbei Processing and Transformation Zone and the adjoining Logistics Industrial Park has been basically completed and opened to traffic, and the 6.4-kilometer Chengdong Avenue north extension and Shenka Avenue east extension projects have completed more than 35% of the total construction volume. They have opened up all kinds of dead ends and promoted linkage and integration development. The innovation-driven capacity has been significantly enhanced, and it has been successively named by the State Council as a national-level innovation and entrepreneurship demonstration base and a national-level technology business incubator. They have introduced four innovation and entrepreneurship incubation carrier platforms, including Sunshine Mass Entrepreneurship, China Science and Technology Development Institute, Shandong University Student Entrepreneurship Incubation Base, and Electric Power Institute. The number of incubating enterprises and entrepreneurial teams has reached 120, and 5

new high-tech enterprises have been added, with a cumulative output value of 990 million yuan. The industrial structure has been continuously optimized, and the four leading industries, which are labor-intensive, strategically emerging, foreign trade processing, and modern services, have taken initial shape. The output value accounts for 52% of the total industrial output value of the development zone. Amplifying the policy effect of national development zones, enclave parks in 11 counties focusing on food processing and equipment manufacturing have sprung up. In accordance with the industrial organization concept of "convergence along the chain and cluster development", they have continuously expanded the space for attracting and cooperation, and have achieved remarkable results in attracting investment.

Since 2022, a total of 126 projects have been signed, with a total investment of 18 billion RMB and paid in funds of 4.6 billion RMB, completing 115% of the annual target tasks. And 3.62 new jobs can be created after all the projects are put into operation. The industrial scale has been growing. With 4,049 enterprises entering the zone, 33400 people have been employed, and major industrial platforms for electronic information industrial parks, textile and garment industrial parks and logistics industrial parks have been planned and constructed. The cumulative regional GDP was 9.22 billion RMB, with an average annual growth rate of 29.9%; The construction of the 1,500-mu textile and garment industrial park and the 500-mu electronic information industrial park has started. The main body of the model workshop, office and living rooms of the 1,300-mu mechanical equipment assembly and processing industrial park have been initially built, and the industrial carrying capacity has been continuously strengthened. The opening-up has been continuously deepened, and the Kashi-Karachi all-cargo route has been opened. Yiwu, Baoding, Shenzhen, Lanzhou and other cities have also opened multi-modal transport trains from Kashi to Central Asia and South Asia. Opening up logistics channels to the west has been broadened comprehensively. During the "13th Five Year Plan", the total import and export trade volume has reached 3.6 billion US dollars. In 2021, the import and export trade volume will reach 912 million US dollars, a year-on-year growth of 125.2%, and 120.5% of the annual target will be completed.
